As identified in the above mentioned report, there are some areas where quite a bit of work needs to be done. A range of policies and procedures need to be evaluated against the recommendations made by His Majesty's Inspectors, and following this changes need to be implemented, so that the learning and progress of all pupils continue to move forward.

As the Consultant Headteacher, my remit is to work closely with the Local Authority School Improvement Partner and the Chair of Governors so the improvement can take place at great speed and the school is back on track. My personal priority is the education and well-being of the children and along with staff I am working to make sure we are putting measures into place to make up for lost time.
