Lower KS2 Update

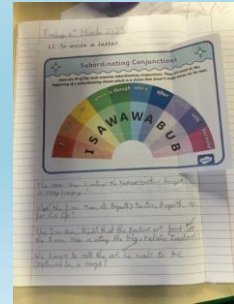
In Years 3 and 4, we have been very busy with our learning since returning from the half term break.

This week we began our writing journey to writing a letter. We began by studying the genre of letter writing. We then moved onto the use of conjunctions within our writing. In Year 4, we have also been working very hard. In maths we have been looking at co-ordinates – including how to translate shapes from one point to another.

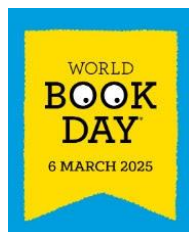
