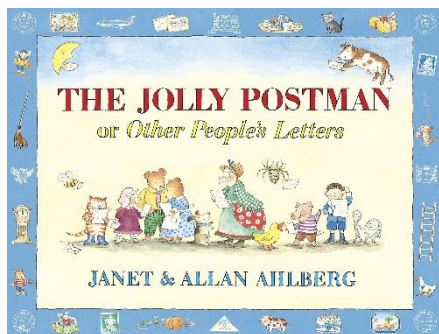


Growing and changing!

Key Areas of Learning

As **historians**, we are looking at the question "How was school different in the past?" We will use timelines and different sources, such as photographs, to help us compare schools up to 200 years ago and schools today.

As **scientists**, we are exploring life cycles of different animals including humans. We will also be observing chicks as they arrive to school as eggs and slowly start to hatch!

English

As readers, we are further developing our phonics to build fluency when reading unfamiliar texts. We are reading *The Jolly Postman* and learning that books can be written in different formats.

As writers, we are learning to write formal letters inspired by the letters delivered by the Jolly Postman. We will be using a range of conjunctions to up level our sentences and we are beginning to re-read our work to check it makes sense and add improvements.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be looking at our numbers 0-100 and using these numbers to do many different skills such as ordering, partitioning and estimating. We will also be starting to look at calculations with our numbers 0-20. This will include adding and subtracting using our number bonds to help.

Computing

In Computing, we are looking at how to programme a computer to make it complete something, as well as exploring what the internet is and how to use it safely. We are also talking about online relationships and our identity.

PSHE

We are learning about what makes a good friend and how we can be a good friend to those around us.

PE

In Physical Education, we are learning about the fundamentals of PE and how to improve our ball skills, such as throwing.

Art and DT

As creators, we are looking at different tones of colours and different textures we can make by using different methods or by using materials around us.

RE

We are learning about Judaism. We are looking at what is special for those who follow this religion and why rules are such an important aspect of this faith.

Music

As musicians we are exploring the pulse, rhythm and pitch of music and how to find it within different pieces of music.
