## Key Areas of Learning

As **historians**, we will be stepping back in time to uncover clues about how people in the Stone Age lived. The children will explore how life and technology developed through the Stone Age, Bronze Age, and Iron Age, discovering just how much the world changed over these fascinating periods of history.

As **scientists**, we will be transforming into budding nutritionists and health experts! The children will investigate different diets and discover how they can be made healthier. They will explore how our bones and muscles work together and find out why exercise is such a powerful way to keep our bodies strong and active.

### English

As readers, the children will explore a range of comprehension texts and develop strategies to help them understand and answer questions. They will also be building their confidence by reading aloud and sharing stories with the class.

As writers, the children will be exploring a variety of text types, including writing instructions for a Stone Age game, an information text about a famous inventor, and even a persuasive speech to convince Stone Age people to try cooked meat instead of eating it raw!

### Maths

As mathematicians, the children will be revisiting key addition and subtraction skills within 10, developing a range of strategies such as using doubles and number bonds.

They will also be learning about place value up to 100, which will help them build confidence when solving more complex addition and subtraction problems. This solid foundation will support their overall understanding of number as they progress through the year.

### Computing

Children will learn about internet safety, including how to stay safe online, how to identify themselves appropriately, and who it is safe to talk to. They will also be introduced to emails, learning how to write, send, and respond to emails safely.

### PSHE

In PSHE, we are learning about how to be a good friend. We will explore what kindness, empathy and respect look like, and learn how to build positive relationships with others.

### PE

In Physical Education, Year 3 are undertaking the start of their learning journey in PE with Netball and football, testing their basic skills & knowledge and combining these into game situations this year.

### Music

As musicians, we will be exploring different rhythms and pitches and how they are represented by musical symbols such as different musical notes.

### Art and DT

As designers and creators, children will explore existing wearable technology, evaluate its purpose and design, and then in groups they will create their own innovative wearable devices.

### RE

Children will explore Christianity and Gurmat by looking at the special clothes people wear and why. We will be comparing to our own special outfits and what they mean to us! We will also think about our own special outfits and try to answer the question: does it matter what we wear?

### Spanish

¡Hola! We are beginning our Spanish journey by learning some essential phrases, numbers from 0 to 20, and how to say different colours.
