Key Areas of Learning

As **geographers**, we will be researching and comparing what it would be like to live in hot places and cold places. We will be furthering our understanding of maps to find the continents and the Equator, using this knowledge to help with our comparison of hot and cold places.

As **scientists**, we will be researching about the different habitats of living things. We will be looking at classifying animals into different groups and looking at their needs linking to where they live.

English

As readers, we will be exploring the story of Look Up! It is a witty twist on a favourite fairy tale, this bold and funny story removes the handsome prince altogether, making Rapunzel the mistress of her own destiny.

As writers, we will be writing a diary and an explanation text using learning from our Power of Reading Book: Rapunzel We will have a focus on using subordinate conjunctions and using past tense correctly in our writing.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be looking at adding and subtracting within 10 and progressing towards adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers. We will be using our knowledge of place value to solve these equations. Also, we will be looking at solving equations adding three 1-digit numbers.

Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at how to use the internet correctly and safely alongside how people perceive others online. We will also be exploring how to create our own pictures on a computer.

PSHE

We are learning about what bullying is and exploring how bullying looks in different scenarios.

PE

In Physical Education, we will be continuing to look at the fundamentals of PE and look at dance, including different rhythms and styles.

Art and DT

As creators, we will be exploring how to build Baby Bear's chair using different design techniques and materials.

RE

We are learning about Christianity and Sanatama Dharma where we will explore what the significance of light is in these two religions.

Music

As musicians, we will be exploring how musicians play in an orchestra. We will look at the different instruments in an orchestra and what part they play when performing.
