## SEND Surgeries

Knowing where to start finding the right support for your child or young person with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) can be overwhelming.

The Local Offer website aims to provide as much advice and information to help you and your family. If you haven't found the information you are looking for on their website, you can also drop in to meet the team in person.

They hold monthly SEND drop-in sessions where you can speak to a professional face-to-face for advice, guidance and support.

They will have team members from:

- Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) team
- Therapies
- School travel assistance
- Special Educational Needs and Disability Information Advice and Support Service (SENDIASS)

Their aim is to reach as many people in Hounslow as possible. You can drop in to any of their surgery sessions without a booking.

## MHST

Hounslow's Mental Health Support Team offer up to eight one-to-one sessions of guided self-help, which is based on cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT) principles. They provide this to parents and carers of primary school children who are demonstrating mild to moderate difficulties with anxiety or behaviour.

## 123 Magic

The 123 Magic Behaviour Management Programme is a virtual 5 week programme for parents and carers of children ages 2 - 12 years diagnosed with ADHD or who display challenging behaviour. The programme aims to empower and equip parents and carers with techniques to use in the home to better manage behaviour, whilst developing their confidence and understanding of their child's behaviour.

Family Hubs deliver a range of joined-up services, focusing particularly on parenting support, infant feeding support, early language support and perinatal mental health support.

By connecting families with these services, we will help address their needs and enable them to build positive relationships with their children and the people delivering the services.
