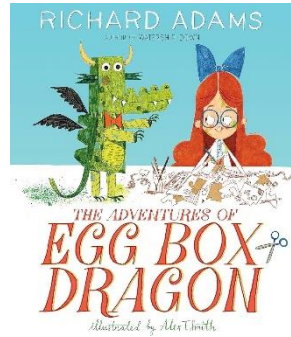


Adventures hatch from boxes!

Key Areas of Learning

As **historians**, we will be researching and identifying significant events that led to the modern era of flying. We will use experiences and inventions from key individuals to help build our own timeline of the history of flight. From the Wright Brothers to Bessie Coleman to Neil Armstrong, we will explore many adventures throughout history.

As **scientists**, we will be exploring materials. We will be looking at properties of a range of materials and how these properties make them suitable for different purposes. One of the properties we will be testing is whether materials are waterproof!

English

As readers, we will be exploring the exciting Richard Adams story, "The Adventures of Egg Box Dragon". It is an enchanting book about a mischievous homemade dragon who finds missing things.

As writers, we will be looking at different text types such as writing a letter, a play script and a new ending to our English book "The Adventures of Egg Box Dragon". We are going to focus on using subordination to add more detail as well as adjectives and adverbs.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be continue looking at shapes, exploring lines of symmetry and 3D shapes.

We will then be moving on to look at multiplication and division where pupils will be learning how to solve multiplication and division problems using a range of strategies including grouping and sharing and using their knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at how to create spreadsheets and what they are used for. Along with further developing our understanding of online bullying and how to use the internet in a healthy way that benefits our wellbeing.

Art and DT

As creators, we will be focusing on our primary and secondary colours, colour mixing and creating textures and patterns using different tools.

PSHE

We are learning about what jobs people do in the community and the different aspects of these jobs.

RE

We are learning about how buildings are used for different faiths and religions. We will be investigating this through focusing on Dhamma and Gurmat.

PE

In Physical Education, we will be continuing to develop our ball skills through sending and receiving, alongside playing games involving a ball. We will also be doing team building to help develop our skills of working together to solve problems and talk to one another.

Music

As musicians, we will be looking at how music helps us tell a story and express our feelings. We will learn how different notes and sounds can help us portray our feelings effectively.
