## Key Areas of Learning

As **geographers**, we will be researching and identifying geographical characteristics of the UK and around the world. We will continue with our exploration of world maps where we will identify the continents and oceans as well as different human and nature made features.

As **scientists**, we will be exploring materials. We will be looking at properties of a range of materials and how these properties make them suitable for different purposes. We will be experimenting to see which ball is the bounciest and which materials are the stretchiest or the most rigid.

### English

As readers, we will be exploring the exciting Emily Gravett story "Meerkat Mail. It is an adventurous story about a meerkat who wants to explore the world and find where he belongs.

As writers, we will be looking at different text types such as writing a postcard, setting description and information text. We are going to focus on using new vocabulary, suffixes and adverbs.

### Maths

As mathematicians, we will be continuing to look at multiplication and division.

We will then be moving on to look at length and height using metres and centimetres. Additionally, we will explore measure through mass using grams and kilograms, capacity using millilitres and litres and temperature.

### Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at what online bullying is and how we can feel safer online. We will also be looking at questioning, where we will explore how data can be used to answer questions and make tally charts.

### PSHE

We are learning about what helps us to stay safe and different strategies to keep ourselves safe.

### PE

In Physical Education, we will be continuing to develop our ball skills through invasion games and target games. We will continue to develop our knowledge of team work through learning these different games.

### Art and DT

As creators, we will be focusing on building a stable structure through our process of designing and building a fairground wheel.

### RE

We are learning about how we remember people and why we remember them. This unit will focus on the religions of Christianity and Humanism.

### Music

As musicians, we will be looking at recognising different sounds and how these sounds are used in music.
