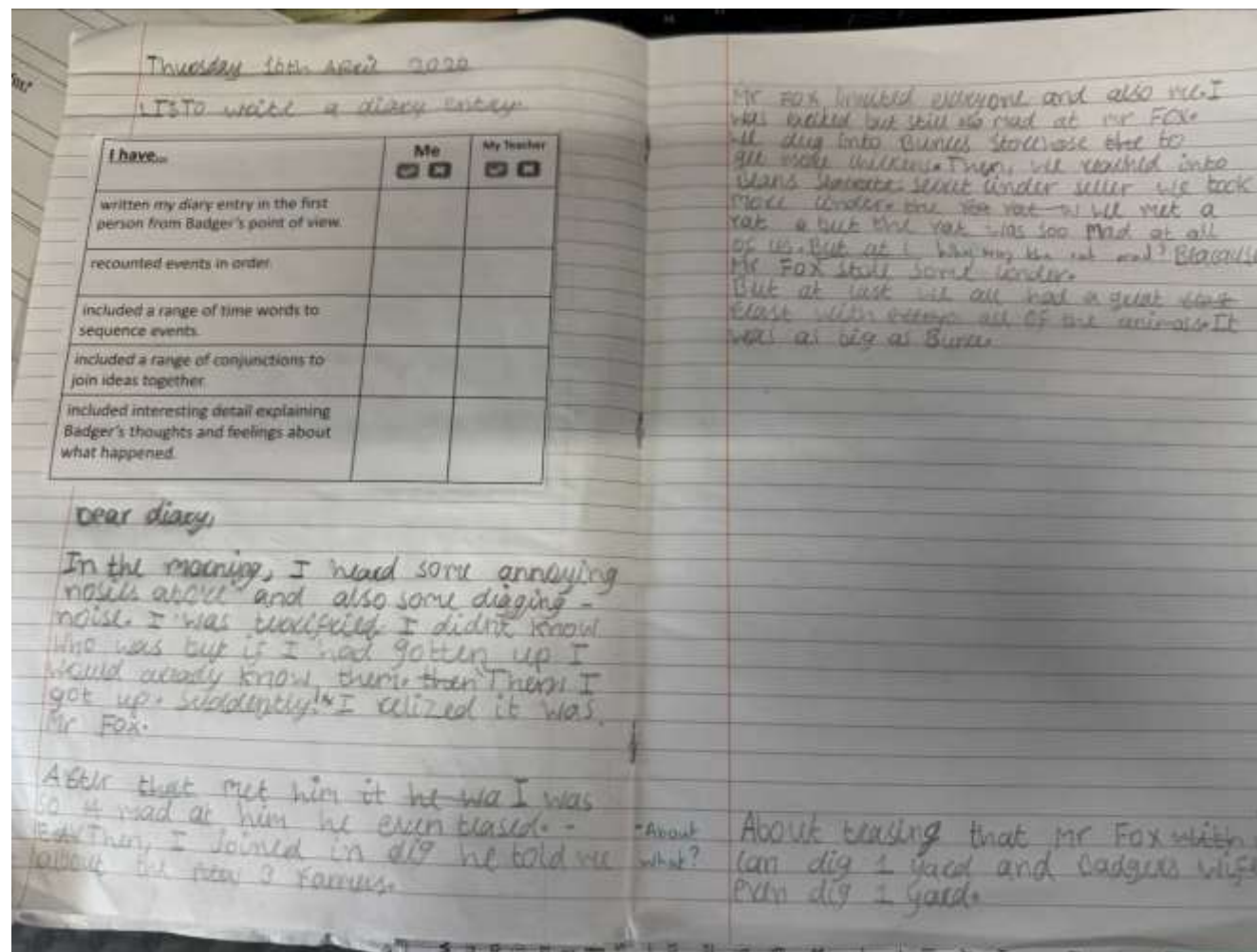

Dear diary:

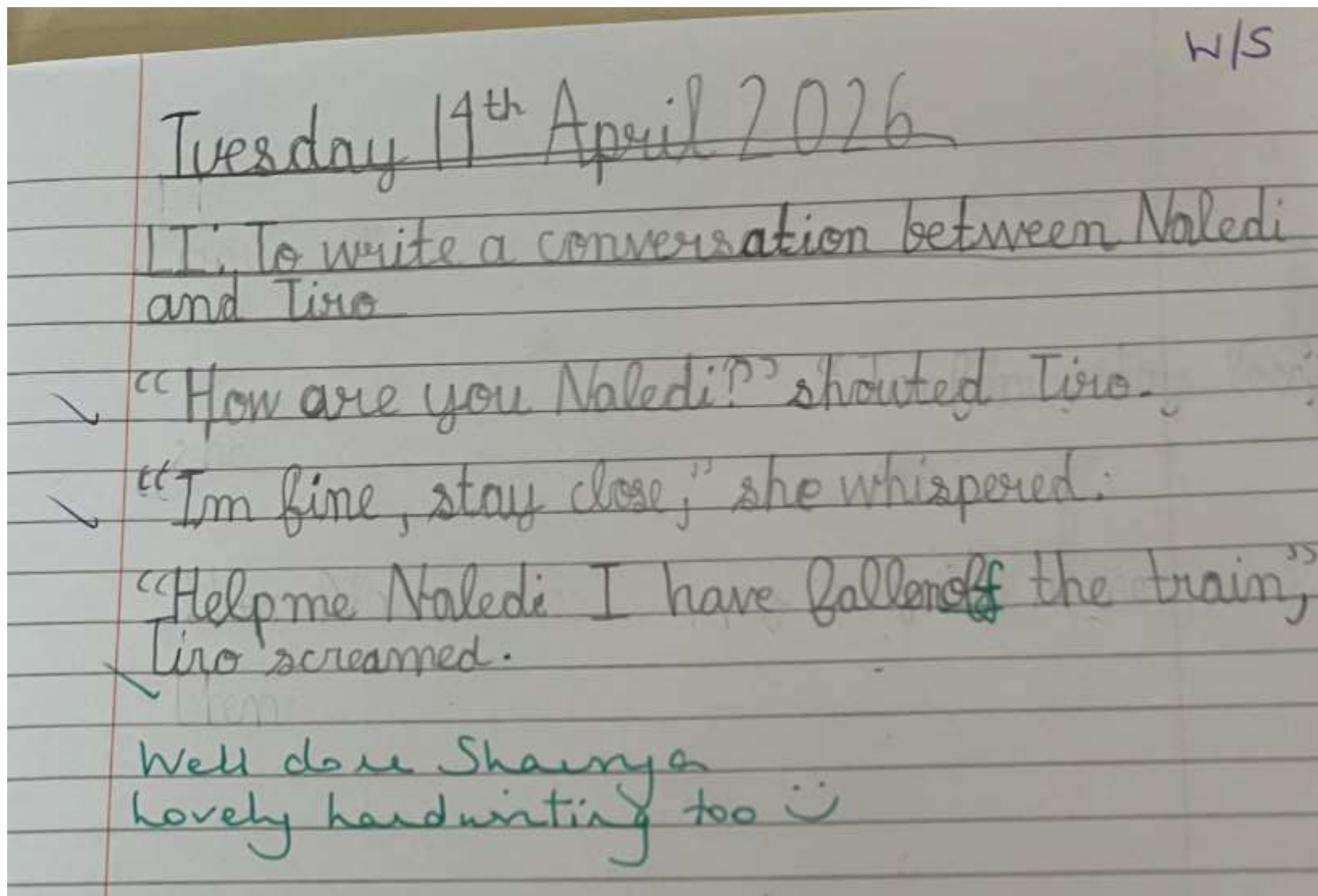
Great introduction I t was busy a while since I last
