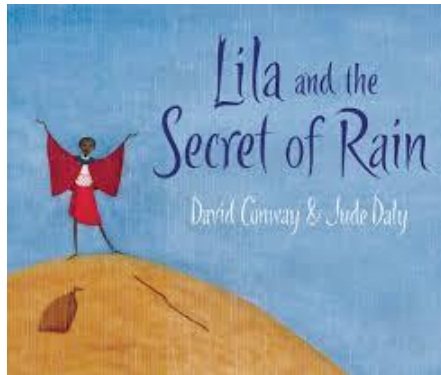


Hope and wonder!

Year 2 Scarlet and Ruby Class Summer Two Term 2026



Key Areas of Learning

As **geographers**, pupils will explore coastal environments and compare them with inland areas. Pupils learn about physical and human features of the seaside, how people use the coast for work and leisure, and how weather and the sea can shape the landscape. Through maps, photographs, stories and practical activities, children develop geographical skills while building an understanding of life in coastal communities.

As **scientists**, pupils will explore the plants and animals found in local outdoor environments. Pupils learn about what living things need to survive, how habitats provide food and shelter, and the importance of caring for nature. Through hands-on investigations and outdoor learning, children develop their observation skills while discovering the variety of life that can be found in gardens and allotments.

English

As readers, we will be exploring the exciting story *Lila and the Secret of the Rain*. Through the text, the children will develop their skills in writing short narratives, creating detailed descriptions, and producing non-chronological reports. They will focus on using exciting vocabulary, clear sentence structure, and punctuation to engage the reader. We are looking forward to seeing the children's creativity and confidence grow as they respond to the story in a range of different writing styles.

Maths

As mathematicians, Year 2 pupils will continue to build their confidence and understanding in maths through a range of practical and engaging activities. Children will learn how to tell the time to the nearest five minutes, including using the terms past and to, and they will apply this knowledge to real-life situations. They will also explore time measurements, including understanding that there are 60 minutes in an hour and 24 hours in a day. Alongside this, pupils will explore position and direction in order to describe movement and turns.

Computing

In Computing, pupils will be exploring Copyright and ownership by recognising content on the internet that belongs to someone and explain why.

PSHE

We are learning about our feelings and how we recognise them. We will explore how feelings can affect people in their bodies and know ways to manage feelings and the importance of sharing feelings with someone they trust.

PE

In Physical Education, we will be working on Sending and Receiving/ Striking and Fielding as well as practising for Sports Day!

Art and DT

As creators, we will be focusing on mechanisms. Pupils will explore ways to make a moving storybook. Pupils will explore sliders and how they work and then carry out their own design and construction.

RE

We are learning about what important lessons we learn from Jesus' stories. Pupils will be able to reflect on their prior learning and how to interpret the morals of the stories.

Music

As musicians, pupils will be exploring the song 'Once a Man Fell in a Well', playing it using tuned percussion and reading simple symbols representing pitch.
