Key Areas of Learning

This term, Year 6 will explore a range of exciting topics across the curriculum. In Science, pupils will learn about looking after our environment, investigating ways to protect natural habitats and reduce human impact on the planet. In History, they will study the Sikh Empire, exploring its growth, achievements, and significance in South Asian history. In Geography, children will develop their enquiry and fieldwork skills by planning and carrying out investigations to collect, analyse, and present geographical data. Through these topics, pupils will build their knowledge, curiosity, and understanding of the world around them.

English

In English, Year 6 pupils will develop their reading and writing skills through a range of engaging and purposeful writing opportunities. They will create a *Year 6 SATs Survival Guide*, using persuasive and instructional language to offer advice and encouragement to their peers. Children will also write a *Leavers' Poem*, reflecting on their memories, achievements, and experiences as they prepare for the transition to secondary school. In addition, pupils will use their imagination and creativity to write an original *narrative*, focusing on character development, descriptive language, and effective storytelling techniques. Through these activities, children will strengthen their ability to write for different purposes and audiences.

Maths

In Maths, as children have completed their SATs, Year 6 pupils will apply their mathematical knowledge and skills to a range of real-life problems and practical investigations.

They will use concepts such as number, measurement, fractions, percentages, ratio, and data handling to solve everyday challenges and make informed decisions. Through engaging projects and problem-solving activities, children will develop their reasoning skills, work collaboratively, and see how maths can be used in real-world situations. This approach will help pupils deepen their understanding of mathematics while building confidence and independence as learners.

Computing

In Computing, Year 6 pupils will develop their understanding of spreadsheets and how they can be used to organise, analyse, and present data. They will learn how to enter and format data, use simple formulae and functions, and create charts and graphs to confidence in using spreadsheets.

PE

In PE, Year 6 pupils will develop their skills in striking and fielding games and athletics. They will learn key techniques such as batting, bowling, and fielding, while also improving their running, jumping, and throwing skills.

PSHE

In PSHE, Year 6 pupils will explore the topic *What Will Change as We Become More Independent*. They will consider the physical, emotional, and social changes that can happen as children grow and take on more responsibility. Pupils will discuss how increasing independence can affect daily life.

Spanish

In Spanish, Year 6 pupils will explore the topic *Let's Celebrate*. They will develop their speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills by learning vocabulary related to celebrations, festivals, and special occasions.

RE

In RE, Year 6 pupils will explore Sikhism and Humanity, considering the beliefs, values, and teachings of Sikhism and how these influence the way Sikhs live their lives. They will learn about key principles such as equality, service, and respect, and reflect on how these ideas connect to wider questions about what it means to be human.
